



FR. LEO VISA APPLICATION -Message from SJB Finance Committee: The Diocese issued a new policy on 15 February 2024 regarding Visa Applications that has a serious effect on Father Leo. The consequence is that Father Leo must find the funds of just under £3.000 to renew his Leave to Remain Visa in September 2024 and remain as our Parish Priest. We have challenged this with the Diocese Admin offices but they have reaffirmed that the Diocese will not offer any financial assistance for this visa to priests who are not Portsmouth Diocesan priests. We, your Finance Committee, believe this is shortsighted and not exactly showing enough value for Father Leo as we believe the Diocese should. We have taken the decision to fund the full amount of Father Leo's Application from Parish Funds. I hope you support this decision as, we believe. Father Leo has been an excellent Parish Priest since his appointment in September 2022.
